Lesley Horne, who tragically lost her 11 year old daughter in an A258 accident told the press following the meeting, *"It was really positive. There need to be safety measures put in place. No improvements will bring the loved ones back, but their deaths need not be in vain."*

I cannot agree more. The families are so decent, have lost so much and yet still find the strength to campaign - not for themselves but selflessly for others in the community. That's real compassion and I could not help but be deeply moved by what they had to say.

For over 10 years this road has been a death-trap and the Conservative team and myself will be getting stuck in to do all we can to keep improvements on the A258 a priority and to do our best to help make a difference. We will keep everyone posted.

Plans for our local library

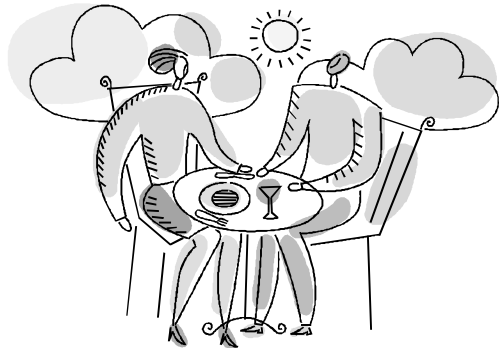
